Overview

As you know, the City of Forest Lake and MnDOT are undertaking a construction project to improve the intersection of Highway 97 & Goodview Ave/8th St. The project includes a new roundabout to replace the existing configuration, including new storm sewer, pedestrian improvements, and bituminous surfacing.



Dates

Competitive bids for the work were received on April 16, 2020 and the project was awarded to Forest Lake Contracting, Inc. from Forest Lake, Minnesota on April 27, 2020.

Forest Lake Contracting, Inc. is currently scheduled to begin work on or after May 14th. The contract completion date for most of the work is August 29, 2020 and Forest Lake Contracting is expected to meet the completion date.
